

INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

1. The name of the school is:

CLAINES CHURCH OF ENGLAND PRIMARY SCHOOL

- 2. The school is a **Voluntary Controlled** school.
- 3. The name of the governing body is:

The Governing Body of Claines Church of England Primary School.

- The governing body shall consist of:
 - a. two parent governors
 - b. one staff governor
 - c. one headteacher
 - d. one LA governor
 - e. three foundation governors
 - f. four co-opted governors.
- 5. Total number of governors is **12**
- 6. **The Board of Education of the Diocese of Worcester** shall appoint **one** foundation governor.

The Parochial Church Council of the Parish of St John the Baptist, Claines shall appoint one foundation governor.

7. (a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex officio:

The Principal Officiating Minister of the Parish of Claines, St John the Baptist (Benefice).

- (b) The Archdeacon of Worcester shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that the ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21 (1) of the Regulations.
- 8. **The Archdeacon of Worcester** shall be entitled to remove any foundation governor ex officio and to appoint any substitute governor.



9. Ethos Statement:

Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.

- 10. This instrument comes into effect on 1 September 2015.
- 11. This instrument was amended at 4.a & 4.f by order of Worcestershire Local Authority on 4 April 2017.
- 12. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governor body (and the headteacher if not a governor), any trustees and to the appropriate religious body.
